Steel work

- Standard 57-foot hull.
- Canaline 38 engine and gearbox.
- Anodes x 4 as required.
- Hull fully Spray foam.
- 1 x side hatch to steel hull.
- Up to 8 x single glazed Caldwell windows (size limitations apply).
- Built in fender eyes.
- Chrome pole fitting pack.
- Rubber fender pack.

Electrics and plumbing

- Electrics completed to client specification including any pre-requested solar panel/tv/Wi-Fi cables.
- Lights and sockets fitted to customers' requirements (maximum spot lights 24 no).
- Plumbing completed to client specification.
- Calorifier fitted to engine and Webasto heating.
- 12 volt and 240 to client's specification (white/ black fittings).
- 6 x 12-volt USB sockets supplied.
- 12 x chrome sockets/switches.
- 1 set of wall lights.
- 1 set of under gunnel mood led strip lights.
- Gas Hob and oven fitted.
- Fridge / freezer appliances (£1000 allowance).
- 2 x gas connections with 1 gas bottle supplied.
- Digital TV and radio aerial.
- 2 x actuator motors for furniture as per customers' requirements (TV/bed/dinette).
- Shower tray and cubical fitted as required (£180 limit).
- Shower mixer fitted as required (£120 limit).
- Bathroom sink and galley sink and taps (£300 limit).
- Shore line power points fitted.
- Horn/ headlamp fitted (£100 limit).
- Bilge pump fitted.
- Diesel gauge.
- Electrical locker at the rear of the boat as per customers design requirements.

Internal fit out

- Boat fully lined in oak or ash veneer or a prefinished painted panel.
- Solid oak or ash cladding allowed below gunnels.
- Ceiling finished in high quality veneer throughout with solid oak upgrade trims.
- Any backing linings stud work that are required within the build.
- Ash/ oak trims upgraded to 30x10mm to cover panels (as required).
- All pipes boxed in veneer boxings (as required).
- Solid wood tops or similar price (not to exceed £800).
- Solid wood flooring or alternative flooring covering (not to exceed £35 per m2).
- Kitchen unit and doors as per client's choice (£2000 allowance).
- Plinth draws to kitchen (as required).
- Floor tiles to galley (£20 per m2).
- Tiles to bathroom shower screen area (£20 per m2).
- Tiles to bathroom floor (£20 per m2).
- Hardy backer board to all tiles.
- Furniture to cabin saloon shower room as per customers' requirements. Units are a pre-finished trim or hardwood veneer (restrictions apply).
- Memory foam mattress supplied.
- Dinette table and dinette seating including seat soft furnishings.
- All furniture doors in high quality veneered or pre-finished doors.
- Two standard bulk heads with doors.
- Door upgrade in one bulkhead to sliding door.
- 3 or 4 roof vents (as required).
- Chrome door ventilation covers (as required).
- Door cards as required to fit doors and side hatches.
- Grooved or flat ceiling boards painted with oak or prefinished to all joints as per customers' requirements. (Small trims allowed to upgrade see Deluxe spec).
- Door bars between all finished floor joints.
- Door stops (as required).
- Ironmongery to all doors and hatches (as required).
- All door linings fitted to all hatches/doors.
- Solid flue stove and flue (£600 max).

Paint work

- Two colours to external in sprayed 2-pack spray.
- Sign writing up to £500 pounds name and logo with bow artwork.
- Coach lines.
- Non slip paint to roof and gunnels.
- Hull of boat blacked in black bitumen.
- Non slip paint to front and rear decks.
- All internal joinery finished in the customers' desired finish or colour (limitations apply).

Final Paperwork

- Fully signed of RCD pack and certificate.
- All instructions for items fitted.
- All guarantees for items fitted.
- All necessary paperwork to register the boat on the inland waterways.

The very easy and customer friendly small print

- There are many items that go into a boat that are simply not listed but all our boats are quoted as a fully finished high quality fitted out boat so if an item is needed to fully finish the boat then it is deemed to be included.
- At least 3 products will be offered within the allowances ensuring they match the clients design and colour options.
- The client gets to change the layout and design as much as they want.
- Client can select their own products within the set allowances without any extras being applied.
- The client has the option of upgrading any item and only has to pay the extra over cost. (i.e. if you selected a tile that was 4 pounds per m2 over the cost of what was allowed then the client only pays the extra over per m2 used for that product).
- An extra hour of labour time is allowed for if a customer choice their own materials and there a little harder to install or use.
- We use a kitty-based system to ensure boats stay within budget. If a product falls below the budget, then this goes into the kitty to allow any items that fall over budget to not increase the costs.
- The client can request normal extras like cratch covers / pram covers and pay the retail cost price.
- The client must select the correct spec that matches their needs to ensure the price is correct as there are items allowed for in each spec that are hidden works.
i.e. Tiles in the comfort spec allow for hardy backer board, wall/floor tile adhesive, grout, tile trims and extra labour element etc. If you upgrade from vinyl flooring to tiles then all these costs need to be considered where if you select the correct spec all these prices are allowed for.
- Our 'build your own boat' download has all allowances built in and is what we use to price all customers boats.
